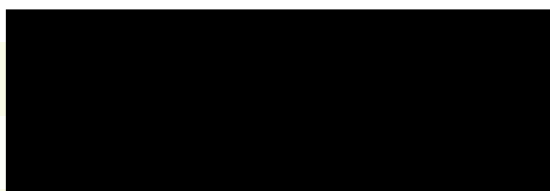

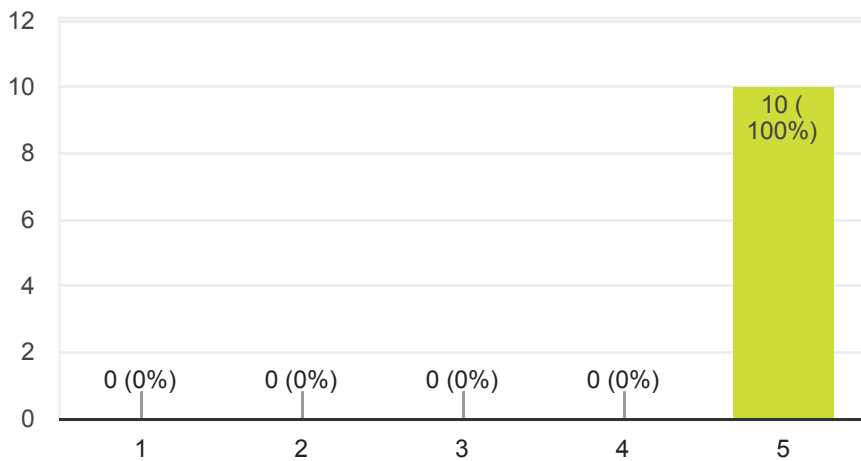

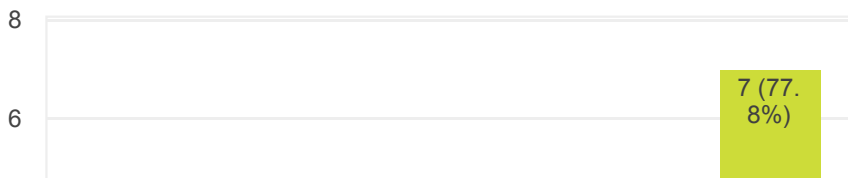
How clear was the information you received from us?

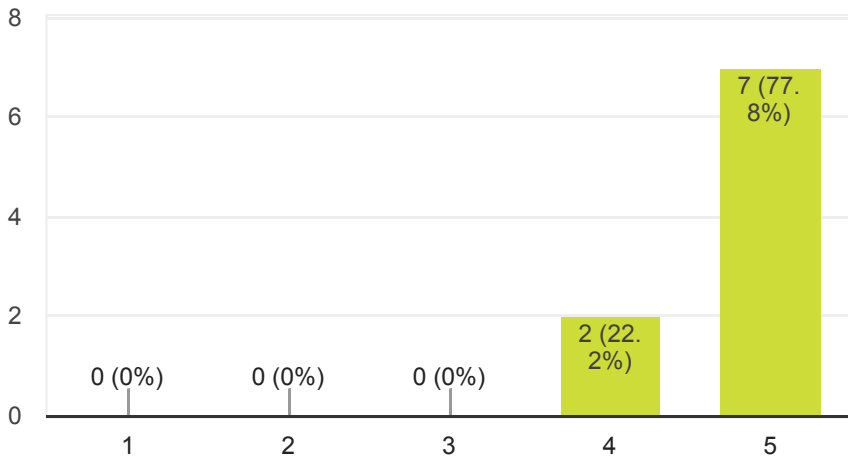
How easy was the process for you?

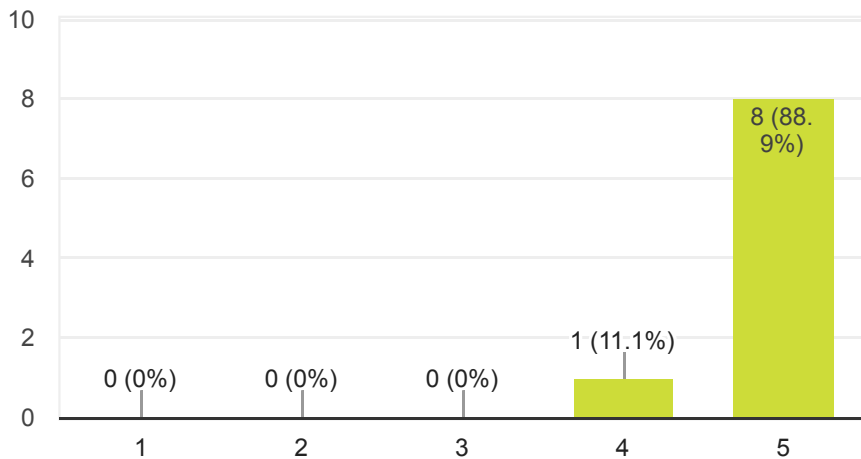
What did you think of the choice of available activities?

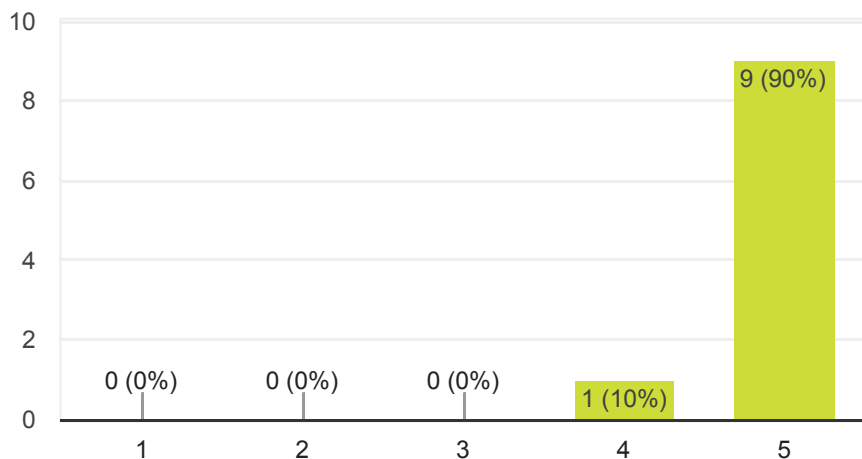

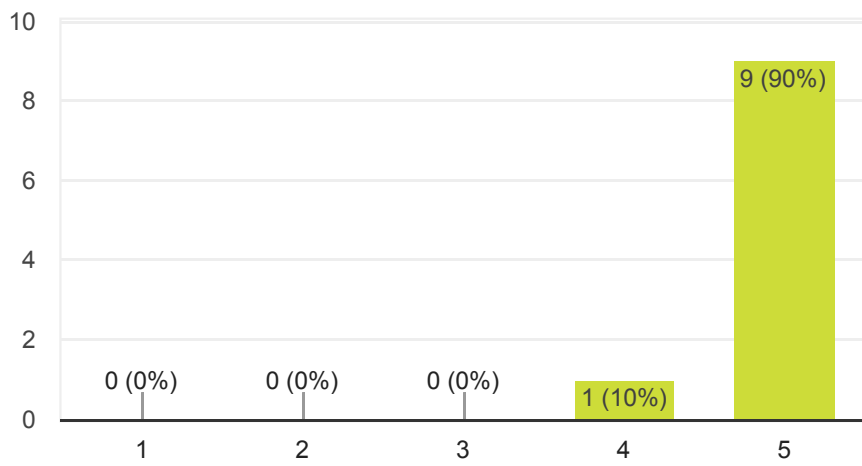
How friendly and approachable were we?

Great staff, nothing was too much trouble. A brilliant mix of educational and fun activities. The children had no idea they were learning.

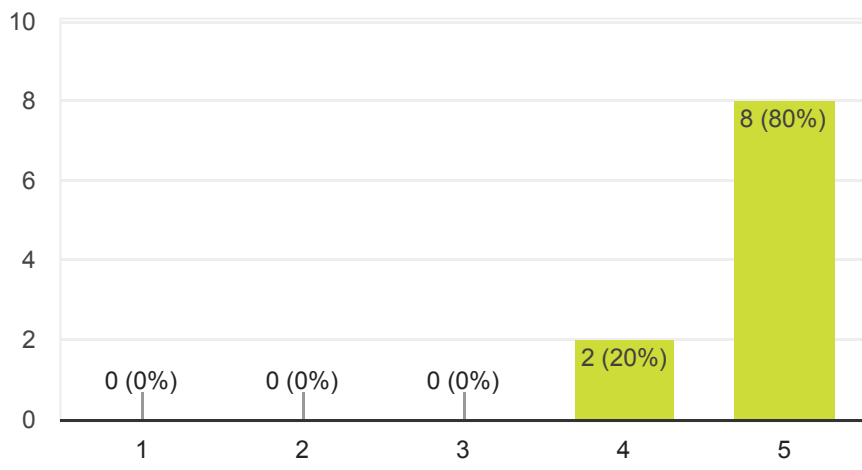
All interacted with the children, even when 'off duty'. Excellent team spirit.

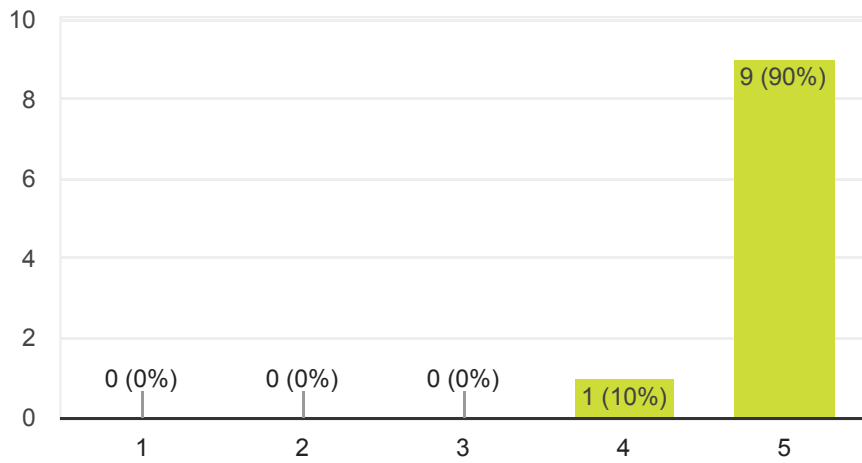
What did you think of the activities we brought?

The children absolutely loved the activities.

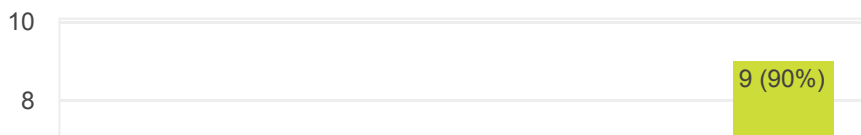
The activities were chosen based on past experience of them, and they completely met with expectations. The children were always engaged and have only had good things to say about the occasion.

The learning experience for every child was fantastic and the intended learning outcomes and more were achieved!

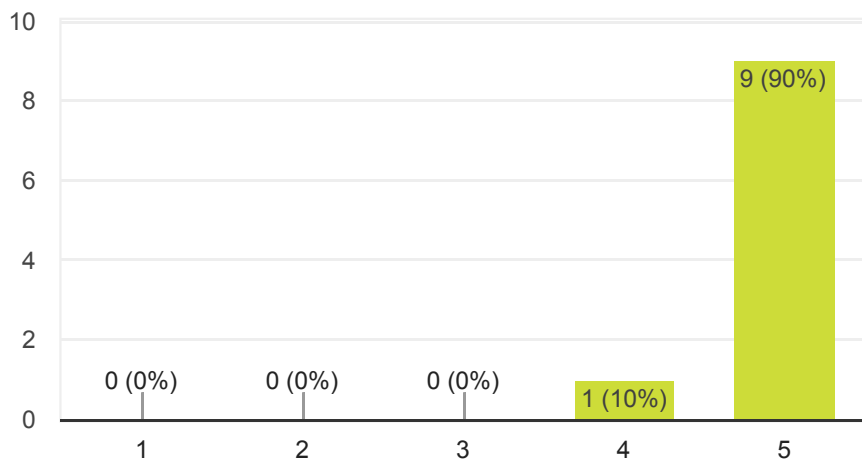
There were obviously curricular links brought out in the activities but we mostly sought support for our values, and these were successfully brought in on many occasions.

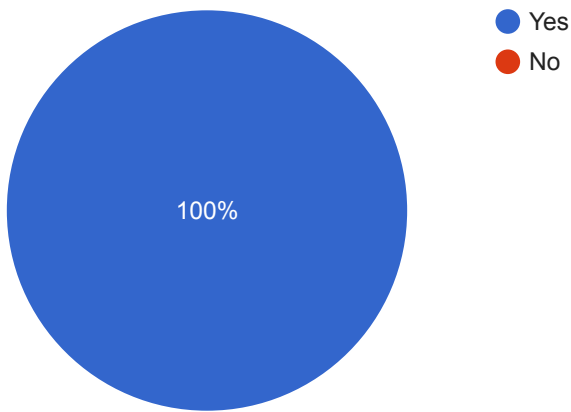
What did you think of your overall camping experience with The Outdoors People?

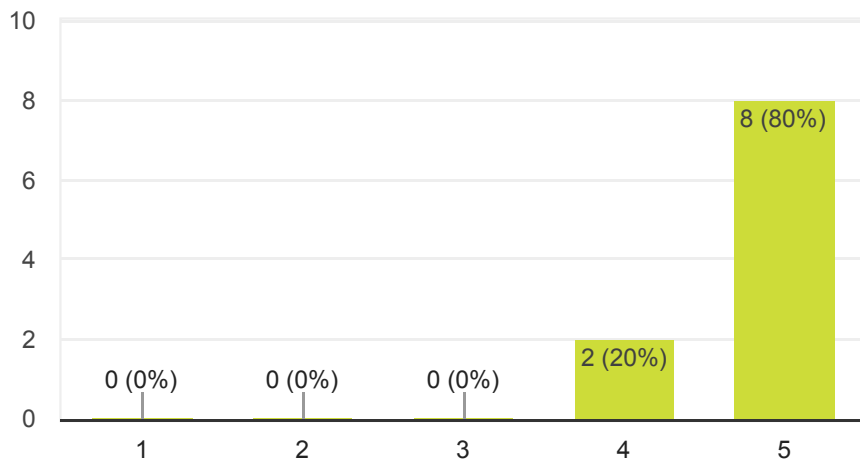

We are delighted to have obtained permission from our incoming Head teacher to camp again next year, and very pleased that you have been able to offer us great dates. Thanks so much!

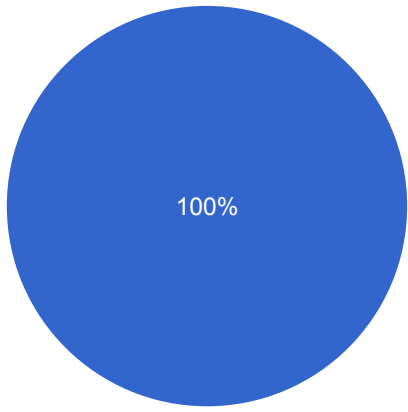
What a fun experience for the school. This was new activity for the school and has now going to be a main activity the children will look forward to each year.
